Horse



Measurements

Standing teddy measures approximately 39cm (15½in), from the soles of feet to the top of the ear

Sitting teddy measures approximately 28cm (11in), from the base of body to the top of the ear

Arm span measures approximately 32cm (12½in) and the leg length is approximately 16cm (6¼in)

Equipment and Materials

One pair of 3.25mm knitting needles (UK10 / US3)

One wool sewing needle

Good quality washable polyester toy filling (approximately 110g)

Optional: Toy safety eyes (12mm in diameter) and toy safety joints (two 45mm and three 35mm joints)

Scissors and pins

Soft tape measure

Yarn

The yarns listed may be substituted for any DK yarn. However, to add volume and texture to the horse's mane I would highly recommend using an eyelash/fun fur type of yarn. The yarn amounts are approximate.

Body, head, arms, legs and ears: **Yarn A** Lang Yarns Merino 120 DK, Colour Almond (096), 70g (168m) for a teddy without toy safety joints and 75g (180m) for a teddy with joints

Head, arms, legs and ears: **Yarn B** Sublime Baby Cashmere Merino Silk DK, Colour Little Linen (344), 25g (58m)

Mane and tail: **Yarn C** Stylecraft Eskimo DK, Colour Old Gold (5494), 30g (54m)

Hooves: **Yarn D** Rowan Felted Tweed DK, Colour Camel (157), 15g (53m)

Harness: **Yarn E** Cascade Yarns 220 Superwash Merino DK, Colour Charcoal Heather (27), 10g (20m)

Pattern Notes

Tension

25sts and 34 rows to 10cm (4in) over st-st on 3.25mm needles.

When knitting toys personal knitting tension is not too much of a concern. However, if your knitting tension is generally on the looser side then you may want to move down a needle size to prevent the stuffing from showing through when the teddy is stretched.

Instructions in round brackets

These are to be repeated the number of times stated after the closing bracket.

Cast on/off

The cable cast on method is recommended. Cast off knit wise unless otherwise stated. When it states cast off *loosely* you may wish to cast off using a larger needle, for example a size 4½ or 5mm.

Cast off requires the use of an additional stitch. For example, if the pattern states cast off 10 sts, you will need to use 11 sts to do so. So please bear this in mind when counting stitches.

Making up

To create a neat, invisible seam when joining pieces use a mattress stitch, with right side of work uppermost. When casting on leave a length of yarn that could be used to sew up the seam if required.

Working embroidered stitches

Thread sewing needle with required yarn and knot end of yarn. Take needle through the stuffed toy and bring it out at the position required. Pull yarn to draw the knotted end right inside the stuffing. Now work the embroidered stitches. Pass the needle back through the toy to come out in a new position between the knitted stitches. Pass the needle back through the toy again between the same knitted stitches to come out at a different position. Repeat until yarn is securely fastened off.

Abbreviations

K	Knit
P	Purl
L	Loop Stitch (Please refer to Tutorial 25 on my website www.knitable.com for instruction on how to knit the loop stitch)
st(s)	Stitch(es)
beg	Beginning
m1	Make one stitch by picking up the horizontal loop before next stitch and knitting into the back of it
Inc 1	Increase one by knitting into the front and back of the stitch
K2tog	Knit two stitches together
SSK	Slip, slip, knit (Decrease - slip the next stitch on the left needle knitwise, then slip the next stitch on the left needle purlwise. Take the left needle and knit through the front of the two slipped stitches on the right needle)
P2tog	Purl two stitches together
SSP	Slip, slip, purl (Decrease - slip the next two stitches knitwise, one at a time, to right hand needle. Move these two stitches back to the left hand needle. Insert the right needle into these two stitches through their back loops and purl these two slipped stitches together)
sl1	Slip 1 stitch (stitch is passed from the left needle to the right needle without being knitted, slip purl-wise)
pssso	Pass slip stitch over (pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch and off the needle)
st-st	Stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl)
moss	Moss stitch (K1, P1)
LH	Left hand needle
RH	Right hand needle
yb	Yarn back (take yarn to the back before working the next stitch)
yfwd	Yarn forward (bring yarn to the front before working the next stitch)
B & T	Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread through remaining stitches on needle, draw up tightly and secure by threading yarn a second time through sts

Toy Safety

This adorable horse is sure to become a much loved, child's teddy, so please ensure that attached pieces are sewn on very securely and seams are tightly finished off. Use only new, hygienic, washable toy stuffing. If using toy safety eyes and movable joints, please ensure that the lock washer is pushed firmly into place.

Toy Safety Movable Joints

To make a teddy without toy safety joints simply follow the pattern as given on pages 5 - 13. However, to make a teddy with movable joints the following adaptations will need to be made to the teddy's legs and arms.

Legs

Work as given for the right and left legs on pages 10 and 11 to **Row 49**, then continue as follows for both legs:

Rows 50 - 53 Beg with a Knit row, st-st 4 rows * *Mark each end of Row 50 to assist the making up of the teddy*

Row 54 K1, K2tog, K24, SSK, K1 (28 sts)

Row 55 *Next and every following alternate row: Purl*

Row 56 K1, K2tog, K22, SSK, K1 (26 sts)

Row 58 K1, K2tog, K20, SSK, K1 (24 sts)

Row 60 K1, K2tog, K18, SSK, K1 (22 sts)

Row 62 K1, K2tog, K16, SSK, K1 (20 sts)

Row 64 K1, (K2tog, K1) 3 times, (K1, SSK) 3 times, K1 (14 sts)

Row 66 K1, (K2tog) 3 times, (SSK) 3 times, K1 (8 sts) B&T

Arms

For both the right and left arm, begin at the shoulder and with yarn **A** cast on 6 sts

Row 1 (K1, Inc 1) 2 times, K2 (8 sts)

Row 2 *Second and every following alternate row: Purl, unless otherwise stated*

Row 3 K1, m1, K2, m1, K2, m1, K2, m1, K1 (12 sts)

Row 5 K1, m1, K2, m1, K6, m1, K2, m1, K1 (16 sts)

Row 7 K1, m1, K3, m1, K8, m1, K3, m1, K1 (20 sts)

Row 8 P17, sl1 to RH, yb, slip the st on RH back to LH, yf, turn

K14, sl1 to RH, yf, slip the st on RH back to LH, yb, turn

P17

To hide the 'bars' that are made when the stitches are wrapped, knit the bar and the wrapped stitch together on a knit row and purl the bar and the wrapped stitch together on a purl row

Row 9 K1, m1, K18, m1, K1 (22 sts)

Row 10 P19, sl1 to RH, yb, slip the st on RH back to LH, yf, turn

K16, sl1 to RH, yf, slip the st on RH back to LH, yb, turn

P19

Row 11 K1, m1, K20, m1, K1 (24 sts)

Row 12 P21, sl1 to RH, yb, slip the st on RH back to LH, yf, turn

K18, sl1 to RH, yf, slip the st on RH back to LH, yb, turn

P21 * *Mark each end of Row 12 to assist the making up of the teddy*

Then continue as given for the right and left arms on pages 11 and 12 from **Row 13** onwards

Horse

Body

Please note that the **mane** is incorporated into the body and head pattern, it is not knitted separately.

Before you begin please make one small ball of yarn **C** from the same original ball.

Begin at the neck edge and with yarn **A** cast on 23 sts

Row 1 In yarn **C** K4, in yarn **A** (Inc 1) 14 times, K1, join second ball of yarn **C** K4 (37 sts)

*By using a second ball of yarn **C** you will not need to carry the yarn behind the work, which gives a neater finish!*

Row 2 In **C** P4, in **A** P29, in **C** P4

Row 3 In **C** K1, * L3, in **A** K1, m1, K9, m1, K9, m1, K9, m1, K1, in **C** L3, K1 (41 sts)

* Please refer to **Tutorial 25** on my website www.knitables.com for instruction on how to knit the loop stitch

Row 4 In **C** P5, in **A** P31, in **C** P5

Row 5 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K31, in **C** L4, K1

Row 6 In **C** P5, in **A** P31, in **C** P5

Row 7 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K1, (m1, K4) 3 times, m1, K5, m1, (K4, m1) 3 times, K1, in **C** L4, K1 (49 sts)

Row 8 In **C** P5, in **A** P39, in **C** P5

Row 9 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K39, in **C** L4, K1

Row 10 In **C** P5, in **A** P39, in **C** P5

Row 11 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K39, in **C** L4, K1

Row 12 In **C** P4, in **A** P41, in **C** P4

Row 13 In **C** K1, L3, in **A** K41, in **C** L3, K1

Row 14 In **C** P3, in **A** P43, in **C** P3

Row 15 In **C** K1, L2, in **A** K43, in **C** L2, K1

Row 16 Continue in yarn **A** Purl

Row 17 K11, (m1, K1) 4 times, K19, (K1, m1) 4 times, K11 (57 sts)

Rows 18 - 24 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 7 rows

Row 25 K24, m1, K9, m1, K24 (59 sts)

Rows 26 - 28 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 3 rows

Row 29 K6, m1, K15, m1, K6, m1, K5, m1, K6, m1, K15, m1, K6 (65 sts)

Rows 30 - 32 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 3 rows

Row 33 K26, m1, K13, m1, K26 (67 sts)

Rows 34 - 38 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 5 rows

Row 39 K9, m1, K49, m1, K9 (69 sts)

Rows 40 - 48 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 9 rows

Row 49 K16, (K2tog) 4 times, K21, (SSK) 4 times, K16 (61 sts)

Rows 50 - 54 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 5 rows

Row 55 K14, (K2tog) 4 times, K17, (SSK) 4 times, K14 (53 sts)

Rows 56 - 59 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 4 rows



- Row 60** P15, turn
- Row 61** Slip first stitch knit wise, Knit to end
- Row 62** P14, P2tog, Purl to end (52 sts)
- Row 63** K15, turn
- Row 64** Slip first stitch purl wise, Purl to end
- Row 65** K14, K2tog, Knit to end (51 sts)
- Row 66** P15, turn
- Row 67** Slip first stitch knit wise, Knit to end
- Row 68** P14, (P2tog) 2 times, Purl to end (49 sts)
- Row 69** K15, turn
- Row 70** Slip first stitch purl wise, Purl to end
- Row 71** K6, K2tog, K6, (K2tog) 2 times, K7, K2tog, K14, K2tog, K6 (44 sts)
- Row 72** Purl
- Row 73** (K2tog) to end (22 sts)
- Row 74** Purl
- Row 75** (K2tog) to end (11 sts) B&T

Working up from the gathered base, join the side edges of the body, leaving the cast on edge open. This seam will be at the centre back of the body. Stuff the body firmly, turning and moulding as you work. The body should measure approximately 32cm (12½in) around at the 'waist'.

Head

Before you begin make two small balls of yarn **B** and one small ball of yarn **A** and yarn **C** from the same original balls. Begin at the end of the nose and with yarn **B** cast on 8 sts

- Row 1** (Inc 1) 7 times, K1 (15 sts)
- Row 2** *Second and every following alternate row:* Purl, unless otherwise stated
- Row 3** (K1, m1) 13 times, K2 (28 sts)
- Row 5** K1, m1, K3, (m1, K4) 5 times, m1, K3, m1, K1 (36 sts)
- Row 7** K1, m1, K7, m1, K7, m1, K6, m1, K7, m1, K7, m1, K1 (42 sts)
- Row 9** K1, m1, K8, m1, K8, m1, K8, m1, K8, m1, K8, m1, K1 (48 sts)
- Row 11** K1, m1, K9, m1, K9, m1, K10, m1, K9, m1, K9, m1, K1 (54 sts)
- Row 13** Knit
- Row 15** K1, m1, K52, m1, K1 (56 sts)
- Row 17** Knit
- Row 19** Knit
- Row 21** In **B** K23, join 1st ball of yarn **A** m1, K2, m1, K1, join 2nd ball of yarn **B** K4, join 2nd ball of yarn **A** K1, m1, K2, m1, join 3rd ball of yarn **B** K23 (60 sts)
- By joining separate balls of yarns you will not need to carry the yarn behind the work, which gives a neater finish!*
- Row 22** In **B** P21, in **A** SSP, P5, in **B** P4, in **A** P5, P2tog, in **B** P21 (58 sts)

Break the 1st ball of yarn A and re-join it at the start of row 23

Row 23 In **A** K4, (K2tog) 9 times, K2, m1, K2, m1, K1, in **B** K4, in **A** K1, m1, K2, m1, K2, (SSK) 9 times, K4 (44 sts)

Row 24 In **A** P20, in **B** P4, in **A** P20

Row 25 In **A** K16, m1, K2, m1, K2, in **B** K4, in **A** K2, m1, K2, m1, K16 (48 sts)

Row 26 In **A** P22, in **B** P4, in **A** P22

Row 27 In **A** K18, m1, K2, m1, K2, in **B** K2, m1, K2, in **A** K2, m1, K2, m1, K18 (53 sts)

Row 28 In **A** P24, in **B** P5, in **A** P24

Row 29 In **A** K19, m1, K2, m1, K3, in **B** K5, in **A** K3, m1, K2, m1, K19 (57 sts)

Row 30 In **A** P26, in **B** P5, in **A** P26

Row 45 In **A** K36, in **C** L8, in **A** K36

Row 46 Join 2nd ball of yarn **C** P4, in **A** P31, in **C** P10, in **A** P31, join 3rd ball of yarn **C** P4

Row 47 In **C** K1, L3, in **A** K31, in **C** L10, in **A** K31, in **C** L3, K1

Row 48 In **C** P5, in **A** P30, in **C** P10, in **A** P30, in **C** P5

Row 49 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K9, K2tog, K8, K2tog, K9, in **C** L10, in **A** K9, SSK, K8, SSK, K9, in **C** L4, K1 (76 sts)

Row 50 In **C** P4, P2tog, in **A** P26, in **C** SSP, P8, P2tog, in **A** P26, in **C** SSP, P4 (72 sts)

Row 51 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K7, K2tog, K7, K2tog, K8, in **C** L10, in **A** K8, SSK, K7, SSK, K7, in **C** L4, K1 (68 sts)

Row 52 In **C** P4, P2tog, in **A** P22, in **C** SSP, P8, P2tog, in **A** P22, in **C** SSP, P4 (64 sts)

Row 53 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K6, K2tog, K6, K2tog, K6, in **C** L10, in **A** K6, SSK, K6, SSK, K6, in **C** L4, K1 (60 sts)

Row 54 In **C** P4, P2tog, in **A** P18, in **C** SSP, P8, P2tog, in **A** P18, in **C** SSP, P4 (56 sts)

Row 55 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K4, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K5, in **C** L10, in **A** K5, SSK, K5, SSK, K4, in **C** L4, K1 (52 sts)

Row 59 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K1, K2tog, K3, K2tog, K2, in **C** L10, in **A** K2, SSK, K3, SSK, K1, in **C** L4, K1 (36 sts)

Row 60 In **C** P4, P2tog, in **A** P6, in **C** SSP, P8, P2tog, in **A** P6, in **C** SSP, P4 (32 sts)

Row 61 In **C** K1, L4, in **A** K2tog, K2, K2tog, in **C** L10, in **A** SSK, K2, SSK, in **C** L4, K1 (28 sts)

Row 62 Continue in yarn **C** P2, (P2tog, P2) 3 times, (P2, P2tog) 3 times, P2 (22 sts)

Row 63 K1, L20, K1

Row 64 P1, (P2tog, P1) 7 times (15 sts)

Row 65 K1, L13, K1

Row 66 P1, (P2tog) 7 times (8 sts)

Row 67 K1, L6, K1 B&T

Work a gathering thread through the cast on stitches at the nose, pull up tightly and join the seam from the nose to the chin. Then working down from the gathered back of head, join the seam, leaving an opening of approximately 3.5cm at the base of the head. Fill the head with small amounts of stuffing at a time, taking care to push the stuffing well into the nose to shape it. The head should be firm to the touch but avoid overstretching the stitches.

Mark eye positions with pins. The centre of each eye lies approximately on **Row 23**, and there are 6 clear stitches between each eye. Thread a sewing needle with black or brown yarn and tie a knot 5cm from the end of the yarn. Insert the needle into the opening at the base of the head and bring it out in the centre of one of the marked eye positions (please see instructions on page 2 for *working embroidered stitches*). Then work a series of small back stitches to build up a circular shaped eye. Fasten off yarn. Then work the other eye in the same way, aiming to make the eyes equally sized. Alternatively, you could use toy safety eyes.

Nostrils *(make two)*

Begin at the top of the nostril and with yarn **D** cast on 15 sts B&T

Fold the piece in half and working up from the gathered centre join the side and then the top edges. Curve the piece into a nostril shape, and position and sew the nostrils onto the horse's nose as illustrated below.

Ears

Outer Ear (make two)

Begin at the base of the ear and with yarn **A** cast on 14 sts

Row 1 K1, (Inc 1, K1) 6 times, K1 (20 sts)

Row 2 P1, P2tog, P14, SSP, P1 (18 sts)

Row 3 K1, SSK, K1, m1, K10, m1, K1, K2tog, K1 (18 sts)

Row 4 P8, P2tog, P8 (17 sts)

Row 5 K1, SSK, K1, m1, K9, m1, K1, K2tog, K1 (17 sts)

Rows 6 - 8 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 3 rows

Row 9 K5, SSK, K3, K2tog, K5 (15 sts)

Rows 10 - 11 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 2 rows

Row 12 P1, SSP, P9, P2tog, P1 (13 sts)

Rows 13 - 14 Beg with a Knit row, st-st 2 rows

Row 15 K1, K2tog, K7, SSK, K1 (11 sts)

Row 16 Purl



- Row 17** K1, K2tog, K5, SSK, K1 (9 sts)
Row 18 Purl
Row 19 K1, K2tog, K3, SSK, K1 (7 sts)
Row 20 P1, SSP, P1, P2tog, P1 (5 sts)
Row 21 K2, K2tog, K1 (4 sts)
Row 22 SSP, P2tog (2 sts) B&T

Inner Ear (make two)

Begin at the base of the ear and with yarn **B** cast on 7 sts

- Row 1** (K1, Inc 1, K2, Inc 1, K2) (9 sts)
Row 2 *Next and every following alternate row:*
Purl, unless otherwise stated
Row 3 K3, m1, K3, m1, K3 (11 sts)
Row 5 K3, m1, K5, m1, K3 (13 sts)
Row 7 K6, K2tog, K5 (12 sts)
Rows 8 - 9 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 2 rows
Row 10 P1, SSP, P6, P2tog, P1 (10 sts)
Rows 11 - 12 Beg with a Knit row, st-st 2 rows
Row 13 K1, K2tog, K4, SSK, K1 (8 sts)
Row 14 Purl
Row 15 K1, K2tog, K2, SSK, K1 (6 sts)
Row 16 Purl
Row 17 K1, K2tog, SSK, K1 (4 sts)
Row 18 P1, P2tog, P1 (3 sts)
Row 19 sl1, K2tog, psso (1 sts) B&T



Place the inner ear piece on top of the outer piece and neatly oversew the side edges together. Gently curve the ears inwards and sew the ears onto the head securely (the ears are positioned approximately 7cm apart).

Close the opening at the base of the head. Position the head onto the neck opening and sew in place.

Harness

Noseband With yarn **E** cast on 57 sts

- Row 1** (K1, P1) to end
Row 2 Cast off *loosely*

Rein With yarn **E** cast on 89 sts

- Row 1** (K1, P1) to end
Row 2 Cast off *loosely*

Join the seam of the noseband. Use the rein cast on and cast off tails to attach the rein to the noseband.

Right Leg

Before you begin make one small ball of yarn **B** and yarn **D** from the same original balls.

Begin at the sole of the foot and with yarn **D** cast on 7 sts

Row 1 (Inc 1) 6 times, K1 (13 sts)

Row 2 *Second and every following alternate row:* (K1, P1) to end, unless otherwise stated

Row 3 K1, (m1, K1) 11 times, K1 (24 sts)

Row 5 (K1, m1, K1) 12 times (36 sts)

Row 7 (K1, m1, K2) 12 times (48 sts)

Row 9 Knit

Row 11 Knit

Rows 12 - 13 Beg with a Knit row, st-st 2 rows

Row 14 In **D** K37, join 1st ball of yarn **B** K4, join 2nd ball of yarn **D** K7

Row 15 In **D** P5, in **B** P3, K1, P1, K1, P2, in **D** P35

Row 16 In **D** K33, in **B** K3, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K2, in **D** K3

Row 17 In **D** P1, in **B** P3, (K1, P1) 6 times, P1, in **D** P31

Row 18 Join 2nd ball of yarn **B** K2, in **D** K27, in **B** K3, (P1, K1) 8 times

Row 19 In **B** (K1, P1) 10 times, P1, in **D** P23, in **B** P3, K1

Row 20 In **B** (K1, P1) 2 times, K2, in **D** (K2tog) 10 times, in **B** K2,
(P1, K1) 10 times (38 sts)

Row 21 In **B** (K1, P1) 2 times, P2tog, SSP, P2tog, SSP, (K1, P1) 5 times, P2,
in **D** P6, in **B** P3, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1 (34 sts)

Row 22 Continue in **B** (K1, P1) 2 times, (K2tog) 7 times, (P1, K1) 8 times (27 sts)

Rows 23 - 29 (K1, P1) to end, moss stitch 7 rows

Rows 30 - 35 Continue in yarn **A**, beg with a Knit row, st-st 6 rows

Row 36 K7, m1, K13, m1, K7 (29 sts)

Rows 37 - 43 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 7 rows

Row 44 K14, m1, K15 (30 sts)

Rows 45 - 49 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 5 rows

Row 50 Cast off 2 sts, Knit to last 2 sts, slip these 2 sts purl wise (28 sts)

Row 51 Bring yarn to front of row, cast off 2 sts purl wise, Purl to end of row (26 sts)

Row 52 K2tog, K22, SSK (24 sts)

Row 53 *Next and every following alternate row:* Purl, unless otherwise stated

Row 54 K2tog, K20, SSK (22 sts)

Row 56 K2tog, K18, SSK (20 sts)

Row 58 K2tog, K16, SSK (18 sts)

Row 59 SSP, P14, P2tog (16 sts)

Row 60 K2tog, K12, SSK (14 sts)

Row 61 SSP, P10, P2tog (12 sts)

Row 62 (K2tog) 3 times, (SSK) 3 times (6 sts)

Row 63 Cast off *loosely*



Left Leg

Work as given for the right leg to **Row 13**

Then continue as follows:

Row 14 In **D** K7, join 1st ball of yarn **B** K4, join 2nd ball of yarn **D** K37

Row 15 In **D** P35, in **B** P2, K1, P1, K1, P3, in **D** P5

Row 16 In **D** K3, in **B** K2, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, K3, in **D** K33

Row 17 In **D** P31, in **B** P1, (P1, K1) 6 times, P3, in **D** P1

Row 18 In **B** (K1, P1) 8 times, K3, in **D** K27, join 2nd ball of yarn **B** K2

Row 19 In **B** K1, P3, in **D** P23, in **B** P1, (P1, K1) 10 times

Row 20 In **B** (K1, P1) 10 times, K2, in **D** (K2tog) 10 times, in **B** K2, (P1, K1) 2 times (38 sts)

Row 21 In **B** K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P3, in **D** P6, in **B** P2, (P1, K1) 5 times, P2tog, SSP, P2tog, SSP, (P1, K1) 2 times (34 sts)

Row 22 Continue in **B** (K1, P1) 8 times, (K2tog) 7 times, (P1, K1) 2 times (27 sts)

Rows 23 - 29 (K1, P1) to end, moss stitch 7 rows

Rows 30 - 35 Continue in yarn **A**, beg with a Knit row, st-st 6 rows

Row 36 K7, m1, K13, m1, K7 (29 sts)

Rows 37 - 43 Beg with a Purl row, st-st 7 rows

Row 44 K15, m1, K14 (30 sts)

Then continue as given for the right leg from **Row 45** to the end

Using yarn **D** work a gathering thread through the cast on stitches at the sole of the foot, pull up tightly and join the seam from the sole of the foot to just beyond the ankle. Stuff the foot and ankle firmly, shaping as you go. Then join the rest of the seam using yarn **A**, leaving the top shaped edges open. Fill the rest of the leg, thinning the stuffing slightly at the top of the leg to enable sitting. Place the base of the body on a flat surface, position the legs against the sides of the body and pin in place, should you wish. Check that the teddy sits properly and adjust legs if necessary. There should be about 8 stitches between the legs at the front of the body. Sew the legs in place, pushing a little more stuffing in the tops of the legs if necessary, before completely sewing.

Right Arm

Before you begin make one small ball of yarn **B** and yarn **D** from the same original balls.

Begin at the shoulder and with yarn **A** cast on 8 sts

Row 1 Knit

Row 2 *Second and every following alternate row:* Purl

Row 3 K1, m1, K2, m1, K2, m1, K2, m1, K1 (12 sts)

Row 5 K1, m1, K10, m1, K1 (14 sts)

Row 7 K1, m1, K12, m1, K1 (16 sts)

Row 9 K1, m1, K14, m1, K1 (18 sts)

Row 10 Inc 1, P16, Inc 1 (20 sts)

Row 11 Inc 1, K18, Inc 1 (22 sts)

Row 12 Inc 1, P20, Inc 1 (24 sts)

Rows 13 - 34 Beg with a Knit row, st-st 22 rows

Row 35 Continue in yarn **B** K12, m1, K12 (25 sts)

Rows 36 - 40 (K1, P1) to end, moss stitch 5 rows

Row 41 In **B** (K1, P1) 8 times, join 1st ball of yarn **D** K4, join 2nd ball of yarn **B** (K1, P1) 2 times, K1

Row 42 In **B** K1, P1, K1, in **D** P8, in **B** (P1, K1) 7 times

Row 43 In **B** (K1, P1) 6 times, in **D** K5, m1, K2, m1, K5, in **B** K1 (27 sts)

Row 44 In **D** P17, in **B** (P1, K1) 4 times,
join 2nd ball of yarn **D** P2

Row 45 In **D** K4, in **B** (K1, P1) 2 times, in **D** K19

Rows 46 - 47 Continue in yarn **D**, beg with a Purl row,
st-st 2 rows

Row 48 Knit

Row 49 (K1, P1) to end

Row 50 (K5, K2tog) 3 times, K6 (24 sts)

Row 51 (K1, P1) to end

Row 52 (K1, K2tog) 8 times (16 sts)

Row 53 (K1, P1) to end

Row 54 (K2tog) to end (8 sts) B&T

Left Arm

Work as given for the right arm to **Row 40**,
then continue as follows:

Row 41 In **B** (K1, P1) 2 times, K1, join 1st ball of yarn **D** K4,
join 2nd ball of yarn **B** (P1, K1) 8 times

Row 42 In **B** (K1, P1) 7 times, in **D** P8, in **B** K1, P1, K1

Row 43 In **B** K1, in **D** K5, m1, K2, m1, K5, in **B** (P1, K1) 6 times (27 sts)

Row 44 Join 2nd ball of yarn **D** P2, in **B** (K1, P1) 4 times, in **D** P17

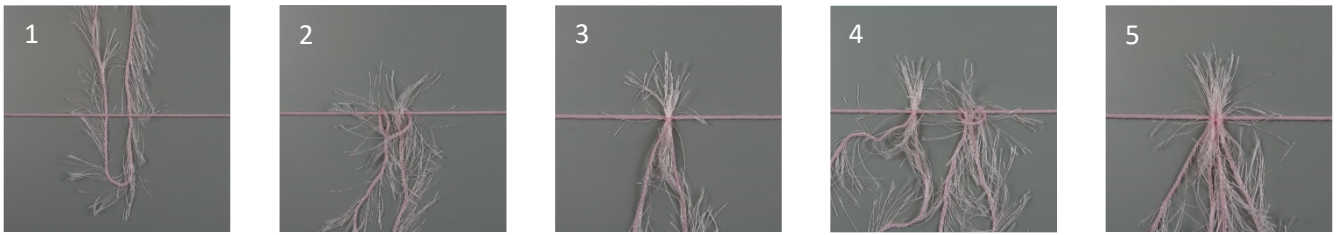
Row 45 In **D** K19, in **B** (P1, K1) 2 times, in **D** K4

Then continue as given for the right arm from **Row 46** to the end

Working up from the gathered hand, join the side edges of the arm, leaving the top shaped edges open. Stuff the arm, turning and moulding as you work. Pin the arms to the sides of the body. Attach the arms to the body by slipstitching around the edges, pushing a little more stuffing in the tops of the arms if necessary.



Tail



Cut a length of yarn **A** approximately 60cm in length. Then cut 40 lengths of yarn **C** approximately 40cm in length. Fold a length of yarn **C** in half and place it under yarn **A** (1). Take the two ends of yarn **C** and pass them through the loop (2). Pull the ends of the yarn tight to fix the strand onto yarn **A** (3). Continue to add all the lengths of yarn **C** onto yarn **A** in this way (4), pushing the yarns tightly together (5). Take the two ends of the yarn **A** and tie in a knot, to gather and secure the yarn **C** strands, thereby making the tail. Position and sew the tail onto the body. Then trim the strands so that the tail is your desired length and shape.
