

# Knitables

## Unicorn



### Measurements

Standing teddy measures approximately 39cm (15½in), from the soles of feet to the top of the ear

Sitting teddy measures approximately 28cm (11in), from the base of body to the top of the ear

Arm span measures approximately 32cm (12½in) and the leg length is approximately 16cm (6¼in)

### Equipment and Materials

One pair of 3.25mm knitting needles (UK10 / US3)

One wool sewing needle

Good quality washable polyester toy filling (approximately 110g)

*Optional:* Toy safety eyes (12mm in diameter) and toy safety joints (two 45mm and three 35mm joints)

Scissors and pins

Soft tape measure

## Yarn

The yarns listed may be substituted for any DK yarn. The yarn amounts are approximate.

Body, head, arms, legs, and ears: **Yarn A** Debbie Bliss Rialto DK, Colour White (001), 90g (190m) for a teddy without toy safety joints and 95g (201m) for a teddy with joints

Arms, legs and ears: **Yarn B** Debbie Bliss Rialto DK, Colour Pale Pink (065), 25g (53m)

Body, head, arms, legs and tail: **Yarn C** Lion Brand Fun Fur, Colour Soft Pink (101), 25g

Horn: **Yarn D** Twilley's Goldfingering, Colour Silver (05), 3g

Eyes and nostrils: **Yarn E** Debbie Bliss Rialto DK, Colour Black (003), oddment of yarn

## Pattern Notes

### Tension

25sts and 34 rows to 10cm (4in) over st-st on 3.25mm needles.

When knitting toys personal knitting tension is not too much of a concern. However, if your knitting tension is generally on the looser side then you may want to move down a needle size to prevent the stuffing from showing through when the teddy is stretched.

### Instructions in round brackets

These are to be repeated the number of times stated after the closing bracket.

### Casting on/off

The cable cast on method is recommended. Cast off knit wise unless otherwise stated. When it states cast off *loosely* you may wish to cast off using a larger needle, for example a size 4½ or 5mm.

Casting off requires the use of an additional stitch. For example, if the pattern states cast off 10 sts, you will need to use 11 sts to do so. So please bear this in mind when counting stitches.

### Working in stripes

When knitting different coloured stripes, carry yarns loosely up side of work.

### Making up

To create a neat, invisible seam when joining pieces use a mattress stitch, with right side of work uppermost. When casting on leave a length of yarn that could be used to sew up the seam if required.

### Working embroidered stitches

Thread sewing needle with required yarn and knot end of yarn. Take needle through the stuffed toy and bring it out at the position required. Pull yarn to draw the knotted end right inside the stuffing. Now work the embroidered stitches. Pass the needle back through the toy to come out in a new position between the knitted stitches. Pass the needle back through the toy again between the same knitted stitches to come out at a different position. Repeat until yarn is securely fastened off.

## Abbreviations

<b>K</b>	Knit
<b>P</b>	Purl
<b>st(s)</b>	Stitch(es)
<b>beg</b>	Beginning
<b>tog</b>	Together
<b>m1</b>	Make one stitch by picking up the horizontal loop before next stitch and knitting into the back of it
<b>Inc 1</b>	Increase one by knitting into the front and back of the stitch
<b>K2tog</b>	Knit two stitches together
<b>SSK</b>	Slip, slip, knit (Decrease - slip the next stitch on the left needle knitwise, then slip the next stitch on the left needle purlwise. Take the left needle and knit through the front of the two slipped stitches on the right needle)
<b>P2tog</b>	Purl two stitches together
<b>SSP</b>	Slip, slip, purl (Decrease - slip the next two stitches knitwise, one at a time, to right hand needle. Move these two stitches back to the left hand needle. Insert the right needle into these two stitches through their back loops and purl these two slipped stitches together)
<b>sl1</b>	Slip 1 stitch (stitch is passed from the left needle to the right needle without being knitted, slip purl-wise)
<b>pssso</b>	Pass slip stitch over (pass the slipped stitch over the knit stitch and off the needle)
<b>st-st</b>	Stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl)
<b>g-st</b>	Garter stitch (every row knit)
<b>LH</b>	Left hand needle
<b>RH</b>	Right hand needle
<b>yb</b>	Yarn back (take yarn to the back before working the next stitch)
<b>yfwd</b>	Yarn forward (bring yarn to the front before working the next stitch)
<b>B &amp; T</b>	Break yarn, leaving a long end. Thread through remaining stitches on needle, draw up tightly and secure by threading yarn a second time through sts

## Toy Safety

This adorable unicorn is sure to become a much loved, child's toy, so please ensure that attached pieces are sewn on very securely and seams are tightly finished off. Use only new, hygienic, washable toy stuffing. If using toy safety eyes and movable joints, please ensure that the lock washer is pushed firmly into place.

## Toy Safety Movable Joints

To make a teddy without toy safety joints simply follow the pattern as given on pages 5 - 12. However, to make a teddy with movable joints the following adaptations will need to be made to the teddy's legs and arms.

### Legs

Work as given for the right and left legs on pages 10 and 11 to **Row 49**, then continue as follows for both legs:

**Rows 50 - 53** Beg with a Knit row, st-st 4 rows \* *Mark each end of Row 50 to assist the making up of the teddy*

**Row 54** K1, K2tog, K24, SSK, K1 (28 sts)

**Row 55** *Next and every following alternate row: Purl*

**Row 56** K1, K2tog, K22, SSK, K1 (26 sts)

**Row 58** K1, K2tog, K20, SSK, K1 (24 sts)

**Row 60** K1, K2tog, K18, SSK, K1 (22 sts)

**Row 62** K1, K2tog, K16, SSK, K1 (20 sts)

**Row 64** K1, (K2tog, K1) 3 times, (K1, SSK) 3 times, K1 (14 sts)

**Row 66** K1, (K2tog) 3 times, (SSK) 3 times, K1 (8 sts) B&T

### Arms

For both the right and left arm, begin at the shoulder and with yarn **A** cast on 6 sts

**Row 1** (K1, Inc 1) 2 times, K2 (8 sts)

**Row 2** *Second and every following alternate row: Purl, unless otherwise stated*

**Row 3** K1, m1, K2, m1, K2, m1, K2, m1, K1 (12 sts)

**Row 5** K1, m1, K2, m1, K6, m1, K2, m1, K1 (16 sts)

**Row 7** K1, m1, K3, m1, K8, m1, K3, m1, K1 (20 sts)

**Row 8** P17, sl1 to RH, yb, slip the st on RH back to LH, yf, turn

K14, sl1 to RH, yf, slip the st on RH back to LH, yb, turn

P17

*To hide the 'bars' that are made when the stitches are wrapped, knit the bar and the wrapped stitch together on a knit row and purl the bar and the wrapped stitch together on a purl row*

**Row 9** K1, m1, K18, m1, K1 (22 sts)

**Row 10** P19, sl1 to RH, yb, slip the st on RH back to LH, yf, turn

K16, sl1 to RH, yf, slip the st on RH back to LH, yb, turn

P19

**Row 11** K1, m1, K20, m1, K1 (24 sts)

**Row 12** P21, sl1 to RH, yb, slip the st on RH back to LH, yf, turn

K18, sl1 to RH, yf, slip the st on RH back to LH, yb, turn

P21 \* *Mark each end of Row 12 to assist the making up of the teddy*

Then continue as given for the right and left arms on pages 11 and 12 from **Row 13** onwards

## Unicorn

### Body

Please note that the **mane** is incorporated into the body and head pattern, it is not knitted separately.

Before you begin please make one small ball of yarn **C** from the same original ball

Begin at the neck edge and with yarn **A** cast on 21 sts

**Row 1** In yarn **C** K3, in yarn **A** (Inc 1) 14 times, K1, join second ball of yarn **C** K3 (35 sts)

*By using a second ball of yarn **C** you will not need to carry the yarn!*

**Row 2** In **C** K1, Inc 1, K1, in **A** P29, in **C** K1, Inc 1, K1 (37 sts)

**Row 3** In **C** P4, in **A** K6, m1, K17, m1, K6, in **C** P4 (39 sts)

**Row 4** In **C** K2, m1, K2, in **A** P31, in **C** K2, m1, K2 (41 sts)

**Row 5** In **C** P5, in **A** K31, in **C** P5

**Row 6** In **C** K5, in **A** P31, in **C** K5

**Row 7** In **C** P5, in **A** K1, (m1, K4) 3 times, m1, K5, m1,  
(K4, m1) 3 times, K1, in **C** P5 (49 sts)

**Row 8** In **C** K5, in **A** P39, in **C** K5

**Row 9** In **C** P5, in **A** K39, in **C** P5

**Row 10** In **C** K5, in **A** P39, in **C** K5

**Row 11** In **C** P4, in **A** K41, in **C** P4

**Row 12** In **C** K4, in **A** P41, in **C** K4

**Row 13** In **C** P3, in **A** K43, in **C** P3

**Row 14** In **C** K3, in **A** P43, in **C** K3

**Row 15** In **C** P2, in **A** K45, in **C** P2

**Row 16** In **C** K2, in **A** P45, in **C** K2

**Row 17** In **C** K1, in **A** K10, (m1, K1) 4 times, K19, (K1, m1) 4 times,  
K10, in **C** K1 (57 sts)

**Rows 18 - 24** Continue in yarn **A**, beg with a Purl row, st-st 7 rows

**Row 25** K24, m1, K9, m1, K24 (59 sts)

**Rows 26 - 28** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 3 rows

**Row 29** K6, m1, K15, m1, K6, m1, K5, m1, K6, m1, K15, m1, K6 (65 sts)

**Rows 30 - 32** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 3 rows

**Row 33** K26, m1, K13, m1, K26 (67 sts)

**Rows 34 - 38** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 5 rows

**Row 39** K9, m1, K49, m1, K9 (69 sts)

**Rows 40 - 48** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 9 rows

**Row 49** K16, (K2tog) 4 times, K21, (SSK) 4 times, K16 (61 sts)

**Rows 50 - 54** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 5 rows

**Row 55** K14, (K2tog) 4 times, K17, (SSK) 4 times, K14 (53 sts)

**Rows 56 - 59** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 4 rows

**Row 60** P15, turn



- Row 61** Slip first stitch knit wise, Knit to end  
**Row 62** P14, P2tog, Purl to end (52 sts)  
**Row 63** K15, turn  
**Row 64** Slip first stitch purl wise, Purl to end  
**Row 65** K14, K2tog, Knit to end (51 sts)  
**Row 66** P15, turn  
**Row 67** Slip first stitch knit wise, Knit to end  
**Row 68** P14, (P2tog) 2 times, Purl to end (49 sts)  
**Row 69** K15, turn  
**Row 70** Slip first stitch purl wise, Purl to end  
**Row 71** K6, K2tog, K6, (K2tog) 2 times, K7, K2tog, K14, K2tog, K6 (44 sts)  
**Row 72** Purl  
**Row 73** (K2tog) to end (22 sts)  
**Row 74** Purl  
**Row 75** (K2tog) to end (11 sts) B&T

Working up from the gathered base, join the side edges of the body, leaving the cast on edge open. This seam will be at the centre back of the body. Stuff the body firmly, turning and moulding as you work. The body should measure approximately 32cm (12½in) around at the 'waist'.

### Head

Before you begin make one small ball of yarn **A** from the same original ball and two small balls of yarn **C**.

Begin at the end of the nose and with yarn **A** cast on 7 sts

- Row 1** (Inc 1) 6 times, K1 (13 sts)  
**Row 2** *Second and every following alternate row:* Purl  
**Row 3** (K1, m1) 12 times, K1 (25 sts)  
**Row 5** K1, m1, K7, m1, K9, m1, K7, m1, K1 (29 sts)  
**Row 7** K1, m1, K9, m1, K9, m1, K9, m1, K1 (33 sts)  
**Row 9** K1, m1, K11, m1, K9, m1, K11, m1, K1 (37 sts)  
**Row 11** K1, m1, K13, m1, K9, m1, K13, m1, K1 (41 sts)  
**Row 13** K1, m1, K15, m1, K9, m1, K15, m1, K1 (45 sts)  
**Row 15** K17, m1, K2, m1, K7, m1, K2, m1, K17 (49 sts)  
**Row 16** P15, SSP, P15, P2tog, P15 (47 sts)  
**Row 17** K13, K2tog, K3, m1, K2, m1, K7, m1, K2, m1, K3, SSK, K13 (49 sts)  
**Row 18** P11, SSP, P23, P2tog, P11 (47 sts)  
**Row 19** K9, K2tog, K6, m1, K2, m1, K9, m1, K2, m1, K6, SSK, K9 (49 sts)  
**Row 20** P7, SSP, P31, P2tog, P7 (47 sts)  
**Row 21** K17, m1, K2, m1, K9, m1, K2, m1, K17 (51 sts)



**Row 22** *Next and every following alternate row: Purl, unless otherwise stated*

**Row 23** K18, m1, K2, m1, K11, m1, K2, m1, K18 (55 sts)

**Row 25** K20, m1, K2, m1, K11, m1, K2, m1, K20 (59 sts)

**Row 27** K21, m1, K2, m1, K13, m1, K2, m1, K21 (63 sts)

**Row 29** K5, (m1, K2) 8 times, m1, K21, m1, (K2, m1) 8 times, K5 (81 sts)

**Rows 30 - 37** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 8 rows

**Row 38** In **A** P38, join first ball of yarn **C** P5, join second ball of yarn **A** P38

**Row 39** In **A** K37, in **C** K1, P5, K1, in **A** K37

**Row 40** In **A** P36, in **C** P1, K7, P1, in **A** P36

**Row 41** Join second ball of yarn **C** K5, in **A** K30, in **C** K1, P9, K1, in **A** K30, join third ball of yarn **C** K5

**Row 42** In **C** K5, in **A** P30, in **C** K11, in **A** P30, in **C** K5

**Row 43** In **C** P5, in **A** K30, in **C** P11, in **A** K30, in **C** P5

**Row 44** In **C** K5, in **A** P30, in **C** K11, in **A** P30, in **C** K5

**Row 45** In **C** P4, SSK, in **A** (K8, K2tog,) 2 times, K8, in **C** K2tog, P9, SSK, in **A** K8, (SSK, K8) 2 times, in **C** K2tog, P4 (73 sts)

**Row 46** In **C** K5, in **A** P26, in **C** K11, in **A** P26, in **C** K5

**Row 47** In **C** P4, SSK, in **A** K6, (K2tog, K7) 2 times, in **C** K2tog, P9, SSK, in **A** (K7, SSK) 2 times, K6, in **C** K2tog, P4 (65 sts)

**Row 48** In **C** K5, in **A** P22, in **C** K11, in **A** P22, in **C** K5

**Row 49** In **C** P4, SSK, in **A** K5, K2tog, K6, K2tog, K5, in **C** K2tog, P9, SSK, in **A** K5, SSK, K6, SSK, K5, in **C** K2tog, P4 (57 sts)

**Row 50** In **C** K5, in **A** P18, in **C** K11, in **A** P18, in **C** K5

**Row 51** In **C** P4, SSK, in **A** K3, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K4, in **C** K2tog, P9, SSK, in **A** K4, SSK, K5, SSK, K3, in **C** K2tog, P4 (49 sts)

**Row 52** In **C** K5, in **A** P14, in **C** K11, in **A** P14, in **C** K5

**Row 53** In **C** P4, SSK, in **A** K2, K2tog, K4, K2tog, K2, in **C** K2tog, P9, SSK, in **A** K2, SSK, K4, SSK, K2, in **C** K2tog, P4 (41 sts)

**Row 54** In **C** K5, in **A** P10, in **C** K11, in **A** P10, in **C** K5

**Row 55** In **C** P4, SSK, in **A** K2tog, K3, K2tog, K1, in **C** K2tog, P9, SSK, in **A** K1, SSK, K3, SSK, in **C** K2tog, P4 (33 sts)

**Row 56** Continue in yarn **C** K5, P6, K11, P6, K5

**Row 57** P1, (P1, P2tog, P1) 8 times (25 sts)

**Row 58** Knit

**Row 59** P1, (P2tog, P1) 8 times (17 sts)

**Row 60** Knit

**Row 61** P1, (P2tog) 8 times (9 sts) B&T

Weave in all the yarn ends of the mane. Work a gathering thread through the cast on stitches at the nose, pull up tightly and join the seam from the nose to the chin. Then working down from the gathered back of head, join the seam, leaving an opening of approximately 3.5cm at the base of the head. Fill the head with small amounts of stuffing at a time, taking care to push the stuffing well into the nose to shape it. The head should be firm to the touch but avoid overstretching the stitches.

## Ears

*Outer Ear (make two)* Begin at the base of the ear and with yarn **A** cast on 14 sts

- Row 1** K1, (Inc 1, K1) 6 times, K1 (20 sts)  
**Row 2** P1, P2tog, P14, SSP, P1 (18 sts)  
**Row 3** K1, SSK, K1, m1, K10, m1, K1, K2tog, K1 (18 sts)  
**Row 4** P8, P2tog, P8 (17 sts)  
**Row 5** K1, SSK, K1, m1, K9, m1, K1, K2tog, K1 (17 sts)  
**Rows 6 - 8** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 3 rows  
**Row 9** K5, SSK, K3, K2tog, K5 (15 sts)  
**Row 10** Purl  
**Row 11** Knit  
**Row 12** P1, SSP, P9, P2tog, P1 (13 sts)  
**Row 13** Knit  
**Row 14** *Next and every following alternate row:* Purl, unless otherwise stated  
**Row 15** K1, K2tog, K7, SSK, K1 (11 sts)  
**Row 17** K1, K2tog, K5, SSK, K1 (9 sts)  
**Row 19** K1, K2tog, K3, SSK, K1 (7 sts)  
**Row 20** P1, SSP, P1, P2tog, P1 (5 sts)  
**Row 21** K2, K2tog, K1 (4 sts)  
**Row 22** P2tog, SSP (2 sts) B&T

*Inner Ear (make two)*

Begin at the base of the ear and with yarn **B** cast on 7 sts

- Row 1** (K1, Inc 1, K2, Inc 1, K2) (9 sts)  
**Row 2** *Next and every following alternate row:* Purl, unless otherwise stated  
**Row 3** K3, m1, K3, m1, K3 (11 sts)  
**Row 5** K3, m1, K5, m1, K3 (13 sts)  
**Row 7** K6, K2tog, K5 (12 sts)  
**Rows 8 - 9** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 2 rows  
**Row 10** P1, SSP, P6, P2tog, P1 (10 sts)  
**Rows 11 - 12** Beg with a Knit row, st-st 2 rows  
**Row 13** K1, K2tog, K4, SSK, K1 (8 sts)  
**Row 14** Purl  
**Row 15** K1, K2tog, K2, SSK, K1 (6 sts)  
**Row 16** Purl  
**Row 17** K1, K2tog, SSK, K1 (4 sts)  
**Row 18** P1, P2tog, P1 (3 sts)  
**Row 19** sl1, K2tog, pss0 (2 sts) B&T



## Horn

Begin at the base of the horn and with yarn **D** cast on 8 sts

**Row 1** K1, (Inc 1) 6 times, K1 (14 sts)

**Row 2** *Next and every following alternate row:* Purl, unless otherwise stated

**Row 3** (K1, m1, K1) 7 times (21 sts)

**Row 5** (K1, m1, K2) 7 times (28 sts)

**Row 7** Purl

**Row 8** *P24, yb, sl1, yf, turn*

*sl1, K20, yf, sl1, yb, turn*

*sl1, P16, yb, sl1, yf, turn*

*sl1, K12, yf, sl1, yb, turn*

*sl1, P8, yb, sl1, yf, turn*

*sl1, K4, yf, sl1, yb, turn*

*sl1, Purl to end*

**Row 9** Knit

**Row 10** *Next and every following alternate row:* Purl

**Row 11** (K3, K2tog, K2) 2 times, (K2, SSK, K3) 2 times (24 sts)

**Row 13** Knit

**Row 15** (K2, K2tog, K2) 2 times, (K2, SSK, K2) 2 times (20 sts)

**Row 17** Knit

**Row 19** (K2, K2tog, K1) 2 times, (K1, SSK, K2) 2 times (16 sts)

**Row 21** Knit

**Row 23** (K1, K2tog, K1) 2 times, (K1, SSK, K1) 2 times (12 sts)

**Row 25** (K1, K2tog) 2 times, (SSK, K1) 2 times (8 sts)

**Row 27** K1, K2tog, K2, SSK, K1 (6 sts)

**Row 28** P2, P2tog, P2 B&T

Mark eye positions with pins. The centre of each eye lies approximately on **Row 18** and there are 7 clear stitches between each eye. The eyes are worked in back-stitch. Thread a sewing needle with yarn **E** and tie a knot 5cm from the end of the yarn. Insert the needle into the opening at the base of the head and bring it out in the centre of one of the marked eye positions. Then work a series of small back stitches to build up a circular shaped eye. Fasten off yarn. Then work the other eye in the same way, aiming to make the eyes equally sized. Using yarn **E** stitch the nostrils in place as illustrated. Close the opening at the base of the head.

Place the inner ear piece on top of the outer ear piece and neatly oversew the side edges together. Gently curve the ears inwards and sew the ears onto the head securely (the ears are positioned approximately 6cm apart). Work a gathering thread through the cast on stitches at the base of the horn, pull up tightly and join the seam to about a third of the way up. Working down from the gathered top of the horn, join the seam, leaving an opening of approximately 2cm. Stuff the horn, shaping as you go, then close the seam. To create the spiral, using yarn **D** run a gathering thread around the horn, from the base to the top, in a spiral shape and pull up tightly. Attach the horn to the head as illustrated. Position the head onto the neck opening and sew in place.

## Right Leg

Begin at the sole of the foot and with yarn **B** cast on 7 sts

**Row 1** (Inc 1) 6 times, K1 (13 sts)

**Row 2** *Second and every following alternate row:* (K1, P1) to end, unless otherwise stated

**Row 3** K1, (m1, K1) 11 times, K1 (24 sts)

**Row 5** (K1, m1, K1) 12 times (36 sts)

**Row 7** (K1, m1, K2) 12 times (48 sts)

**Row 9** Knit

**Row 11** Knit

**Rows 12 - 17** Beg with a Knit row, st-st 6 rows

**Row 18** Change to yarn **C**, Knit

**Row 19** Knit

**Row 20** K6, (K2tog) 10 times, K22 (38 sts)

**Row 21** P5, (P2tog) 4 times, P25 (34 sts)

**Row 22** K4, (K2tog) 7 times, K16 (27 sts)

**Rows 23 - 24** Beg with a Knit row, st-st 2 rows

**Rows 25 - 35** In yarn **A**, beg with a Purl row, st-st 11 rows

**Row 36** K7, m1, K13, m1, K7 (29 sts)

**Rows 37 - 43** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 7 rows

**Row 44** K14, m1, K15 (30 sts)

**Rows 45 - 49** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 5 rows

**Row 50** Cast off 2 sts, Knit to last 2 sts,  
slip these 2 sts purl wise (28 sts)

**Row 51** Bring yarn to front of row, cast off 2 sts purl wise,  
Purl to end of row (26 sts)

**Row 52** K2tog, K22, SSK (24 sts)

**Row 53** *Next and every following alternate row:*  
Purl, unless otherwise stated

**Row 54** K2tog, K20, SSK (22 sts)

**Row 56** K2tog, K18, SSK (20 sts)

**Row 58** K2tog, K16, SSK (18 sts)

**Row 59** SSP, P14, P2tog (16 sts)

**Row 60** K2tog, K12, SSK (14 sts)

**Row 61** SSP, P10, P2tog (12 sts)

**Row 62** (K2tog) to end (6 sts)

**Row 63** Cast off *loosely*



## Left Leg

Work as given for right leg to **Row 19**, then continue as follows:

**Row 20** K22, (K2tog) 10 times, K6 (38 sts)

**Row 21** P25, (P2tog) 4 times, P5 (34 sts)

**Row 22** K16, (K2tog) 7 times, K4 (27 sts)

**Rows 23 - 24** Beg with a Knit row, st-st 2 rows

**Rows 25 - 35** In yarn **A**, beg with a Purl row, st-st 11 rows

**Row 36** K7, m1, K13, m1, K7 (29 sts)

**Rows 37 - 43** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 7 rows

**Row 44** K15, m1, K14 (30 sts)

Then continue as given for the right leg from **Row 45** to the end

Using yarn **B** work a gathering thread through the cast on stitches at the sole of the foot, pull up tightly and join the seam from the sole of the foot to just beyond the ankle. Stuff the foot and ankle firmly, shaping as you go. Then join the rest of the seam using yarn **A**, leaving the top shaped edges open. Fill the rest of the leg, thinning the stuffing slightly at the top of the leg to enable sitting. Place the base of the body on a flat surface, position the legs against the sides of the body and pin in place, should you wish. Check that the teddy sits properly and adjust legs if necessary. There should be about 8 stitches between the legs at the front of the body. Sew the legs in place, pushing a little more stuffing in the tops of the legs if necessary, before completely sewing.

## Right Arm

Begin at the shoulder and with yarn **A** cast on 8 sts

**Row 1** Knit

**Row 2** *Second and every following alternate row:* Purl, unless otherwise stated

**Row 3** K1, m1, K2, m1, K2, m1, K2, m1, K1 (12 sts)

**Row 5** K1, m1, K10, m1, K1 (14 sts)

**Row 7** K1, m1, K12, m1, K1 (16 sts)

**Row 9** K1, m1, K14, m1, K1 (18 sts)

**Row 10** Inc 1, P16, Inc 1 (20 sts)

**Row 11** Inc 1, K18, Inc 1 (22 sts)

**Row 12** Inc 1, P20, Inc 1 (24 sts)

**Rows 13 - 34** Beg with a Knit row, st-st 22 rows

**Row 35** K12, m1, K12 (25 sts)

**Rows 36 - 38** Beg with a Purl row, st-st 3 rows

**Row 39** In yarn **C**, K18, m1, K7 (26 sts)

**Rows 40 - 41** Beg with a Knit row, st-st 2 rows

**Row 42** K7, m1, K19 (27 sts)

**Row 43** Purl

**Rows 44 - 47** In yarn **B**, beg with a Purl row, st-st 4 rows

**Row 48** Knit

**Row 49** (K1, P1) to end

**Row 50** (K5, K2tog) 3 times, K6 (24 sts)

**Row 51** (K1, P1) to end

**Row 52** (K1, K2tog) 8 times (16 sts)

**Row 53** (K1, P1) to end

**Row 54** (K2tog) to end (8 sts) B&T

### Left Arm

Work as given for the right arm to **Row 38**, then continue as follows:

**Row 39** In yarn **C**, K7, m1, K18 (26 sts)

**Rows 40 - 41** Beg with a Knit row, st-st 2 rows

**Row 42** K19, m1, K7 (27 sts)

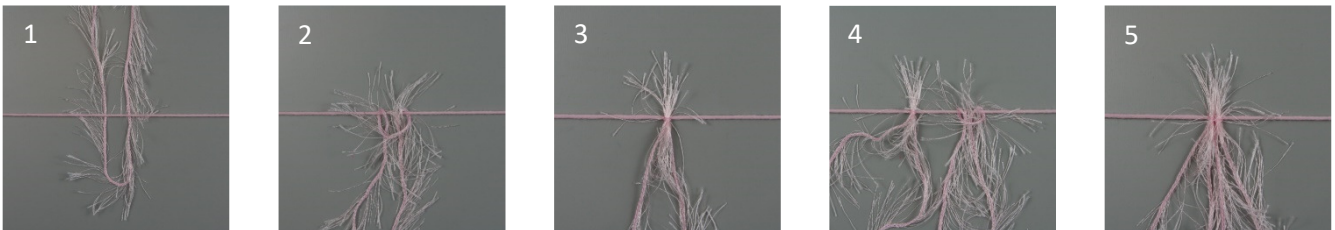
**Row 43** Purl

Then continue as given for the right arm from **Row 44** to the end

Working up from the gathered hand and using the appropriate coloured yarn, join the side edges of the arm, leaving the top shaped edges open. Stuff the arm, turning and moulding as you work. Pin the arms to the sides of the body. Attach the arms to the body by slipstitching around the edges, pushing a little more stuffing in the tops of the arms if necessary.



### Tail



Cut a length of yarn **B** approximately 60cm in length. Then cut 40 lengths of yarn **C** approximately 40cm in length. Fold a length of yarn **C** in half and place it under yarn **B** (1). Take the two ends of yarn **C** and pass them through the loop (2). Pull the ends of the yarn tight to fix the strand onto yarn **B** (3). Continue to add all the lengths of yarn **C** onto yarn **B** in this way (4), pushing the yarns tightly together (5). Take the two ends of the yarn **B** and tie in a knot, to gather and secure the yarn **C** strands, thereby making the tail. Position and sew the tail onto the body. Then trim the strands so that the tail is your desired length and shape.
